ESV	Your people will offer themselves freely on the day of your power, in holy garments; from the womb of the morning, the dew of your youth will be yours.
NIV	Your troops will be willing on your day of battle. Arrayed in holy majesty, from the womb of the dawn you will receive the dew of your youth.
NLT	When you go to war, your people will serve you willingly. You are arrayed in holy garments, and your strength will be renewed each day like the morning dew.
LXX	μετὰ σοῦ ἡ greek The definite article ἀρχῇ greek Meaning: * Beginning * First * Elementary * Rulers, rule, domain Noun, feminine (first declension) Occurs 56 times in the New Testament, consistently conveying the idea of primacy - whether temporal (i.e. the start, e.g. John 1:1) or causal (i.e. the source) or governmental (i.e. the ruler, e.g. Ephesians 6:12 ἐν greek Preposition meaning "in". ἡμέρᾱ τῆς greek The definite article δυνάμεώς σου ἐν greek Preposition meaning "in". ταῖς greek The definite article λαμπρότησιν τῶν greek The definite article ἀγίων ἐκ γαστρος πρὸ ἐωσφόρου ἐξεγέννησά σε
