Hebrew	יְהוָה יְשׁוּעָה בְּאַהֲלֵי צְדִיקִים יָמִין יְהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	Glad songs of salvation are in the tents of the righteous: “The right hand of the LORD does valiantly,
NIV	Shouts of joy and victory resound in the tents of the righteous: “The LORD's right hand has done mighty things!
NLT	Songs of joy and victory are sung in the camp of the godly. The strong right arm of the LORD has done glorious things!

IT is most frequently translated as “and” σωτηρίας ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. σκηναῖς δικαίων δεξιὰ κυρίου ἐποίησεν Meaning: * To do * To make This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.
