Hebrew	פֶּתַח הַשַּׁעַר לַיהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. 	ESV	This is the gate of the LORD; the righteous shall enter through it.
	NIV	This is the gate of the LORD through which the righteous may enter.
	NLT	These gates lead to the presence of the LORD, and the godly enter there.
