	יְהִי כִּי עֲנִיתָנִי וַתִּהְיֶה hebrew The word יהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לִישׁוּעָה
ESV	I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation.
NIV	I will give you thanks, for you answered me; you have become my salvation.
NLT	I thank you for answering my prayer and giving me victory!
LXX	ἐξομολογήσομαί σοι ὅτι ἐπήκουσάς μου καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐγένου μοι εἰς σωτηρίαν
KJV	I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.

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
