	The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.
	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 אָאת הָּיא נִפְּלָאת בְּעֵינֵינוּ
ESV	This is the LORD's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.
NIV	the LORD has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes.
NLT	This is the LORD's doing, and it is wonderful to see.

LXX Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἔστινρlugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example $\epsilon i \mu i$ is the word for am and $\tilde{\eta} v$ is the word for was, e.g. $\theta \alpha v \mu \alpha \sigma \tau \tilde{\eta}$ $\dot{\epsilon} v p luginautotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigėv$
