Hebrew	ברוך
	Meaning
	* To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse
	Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament.
	The word ברוך marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 יהוה יתה
hebrew	
Meaning	
	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
	First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. Exodus 3:14 Deuteronomy 6:4 Psalm 23:1 Romans 10:13 Joel 2:32 Exodus 20:7 Psalm 18:1 Exodus 15:3 Psalm 8:1 Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3 Judges 6:24 Genesis 22:14 Jeremiah 23:6 למדני חקיד
ESV	Blessed are you, O LORD; teach me your statutes!
NIV	Praise be to you, O LORD; teach me your decrees.
NLT	I praise you, O LORD; teach me your decrees.
LXX	εὐλογητὸς εἶ
	greek
	εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμι is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. κύριε δίδαξόν με τὰ
	greek
	The definite article δικαιώματά σου
KJV	Blessed art thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes.
