	Verb occurring around 20 times in the Old Testament. It is sometimes used literally, and, at other times, figuratively.
	Biblical Examples Intransitive sense Used when light itself shines or dawns.Isaiah 60:1Exodus 13:21 מִכֵּיץ פְּתִיחַים
ESV	The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.
NIV	The unfolding of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple.
NLT	The teaching of your word gives light, so even the simple can understand.
