Hebrew	צַעִיר אֲנִכִּי וְנִבְזָה פִּקְדֹתֶיךָ לֹא שָׁכַחְתִּי
ESV	I am small and despised, yet I do not forget your precepts.
NIV	Though I am lowly and despised, I do not forget your precepts.
NLT	I am insignificant and despised, but I don't forget your commandments.
LXX	νεώτερός εἰμι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐγὼ καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐξουδενωμένος τὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article δικαιώματά σου οὐκ ἐπελαθόμην
