Hebrew	קָרְבוּ רִדְפֵי זִמָּה מִתּוֹרַתְךָ רַחֲקוּ
ESV	They draw near who persecute me with evil purpose; they are far from your law.
NIV	Those who devise wicked schemes are near, but they are far from your law.
NLT	Lawless people are coming to attack me; they live far from your instructions.
LXX	προσῆγγυσαν οἱ greek The definite article καταδιώκοντές με ἀνομίᾳ ἀπὸ δὲ αὐτοῦ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. νόμου σου greek The definite article
KJV	They draw nigh that follow after mischief: they are far from thy law.

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
