Hebrew	הַדְרִיכֵנִי בְּנִתְיֵיב מִצִּוְתֶיךָ כִּי בּוֹ חִפְצָתִי
ESV	Lead me in the path of your commandments, for I delight in it.
NIV	Direct me in the path of your commands, for there I find delight.
NLT	Make me walk along the path of your commands, for that is where my happiness is found.
LXX	ὁδήγησόν με ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τριβῶ τῶν greek The definite article ἐντολῶν σου ὅτι αὐτήν αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἠθέλησα
KJV	Make me to go in the path of thy commandments; for therein do I delight.

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
