Hebrew	טוֹב אַתָּה וּמַטִּיב לַמִּדְּנֵי חֻקֶּיךָ
ESV	You are good and do good; teach me your statutes.
NIV	You are good, and what you do is good; teach me your decrees.
NLT	You are good and do only good; teach me your decrees.
LXX	χρηστος εἰ greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. σύ κύριε καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τῇ greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
