	הֵיטִי plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The word הֵיטִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לֹא יָדָעְתִּי בְּקִטּוֹר הָעֵשֶׁן
ESV	For I have become like a wineskin in the smoke, yet I have not forgotten your statutes.
NIV	Though I am like a wineskin in the smoke, I do not forget your decrees.
NLT	I am shriveled like a wineskin in the smoke, but I have not forgotten to obey your decrees.
LXX	ὅτι ἐγενήθην ὡς ἀσκὸς ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πάχνη τὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article δικαιώματά σου οὐκ ἐπελαθόμην
