ESV	Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day.
NIV	Oh, how I love your law! I meditate on it all day long.
NLT	Oh, how I love your instructions! I think about them all day long.
LXX	ιγ μημ ὥς ἡγάπησα τὸν greek The definite article νόμον σου κύριε ὅλην τὴν autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article ἡμέραν μελέτη μου ἔστιν autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
