ESV	I am for peace, but when I speak, they are for war!
NIV	I am a man of peace; but when I speak, they are for war.
NLT	I search for peace; but when I speak of peace, they want war! A song for pilgrims ascending to Jerusalem.
LXX	μετὰ τῶν greek The definite article μισούντων τὴν greek The definite article εἰρήνην ἡμην εἰρηνικός ὅταν ἐλάλουν αὐτοῖς αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐπολέμουν με δωρεάν
