Hebrew	יְהוָה יְהוָה שֵׁיר הַמַּעֲלֹת הַבְּטָחִים בֵּיהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. NLT	Those who trust in the LORD are as secure as Mount Zion; they will not be defeated but will endure forever.
