Hebrew	כִּי עִמָּךָ הַסְלִיחָה לְמַעַן תִּירָא
ESV	But with you there is forgiveness, that you may be feared.
NIV	But with you there is forgiveness; therefore you are feared.
NLT	But you offer forgiveness, that we might learn to fear you.
LXX	ὅτι παρὰ σοὶ ὁ greek The definite article ἰλασμός ἐστιν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
KJV	But there is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared.

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
