Hebrew	אתָּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (יִשְׂרָאֵל מְכַל עֲוֹנוֹתָיו

	NIV He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins.
	NLT He himself will redeem Israel from every kind of sin. A song for pilgrims ascending to Jerusalem. A psalm of David.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
