Hebrew	רוּחַ אֱלֹהִים מְרוּחָךְ Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוּחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). 	ESV Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence?
	NIV Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?
	NLT I can never escape from your Spirit! I can never get away from your presence!
	LXX Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἁπὸ τοῦ The definite article ὁ πνεύματός σου καὶ The definite article ὁ προσώπου σου ποῦ φύγω
KJV	Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
