Hebrew	נִשְׁמְטוּ בְיָדַי סֵלַע שְׁפִטֵּיהֶם וְשָׁמְעוּ אִמְרֵי כִי נֶעֱמָו
ESV	When their judges are thrown over the cliff, then they shall hear my words, for they are pleasant.
NIV	their rulers will be thrown down from the cliffs, and the wicked will learn that my words were well spoken.
NLT	When their leaders are thrown down from a cliff, the wicked will listen to my words and find them true.
LXX	κατεπόθησαν ἐχόμενα πέτρας οἱ greek The definite article κριταὶ αὐτῶν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἀκούσονται τὰ greek The definite article ῥήματά μου ὅτι ἠδύνθησαν
KJV	When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet.

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
