ESV	And in your steadfast love you will cut off my enemies, and you will destroy all the adversaries of my soul, for I am your servant.
NIV	In your unfailing love, silence my enemies; destroy all my foes, for I am your servant.
NLT	In your unfailing love, silence all my enemies and destroy all my foes, for I am your servant. A psalm of David.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τοὺςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article θλίβοντας τὴνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article ψυχὴν μου ὅτι δοῦλός σου εἰμιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be"). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐγώ
