ESV	Rescue me and deliver me from the hand of foreigners, whose mouths speak lies and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood.
NIV	Deliver me and rescue me from the hands of foreigners whose mouths are full of lies, whose right hands are deceitful.
NLT	Save me! Rescue me from the power of my enemies. Their mouths are full of lies; they swear to tell the truth, but they lie instead.
