Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalms 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalms 127:1Luke 2:19יְהוָהplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיְהוָה? hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name Hebrew It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
