	בָּרַךְ Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28Psalms 103:1Numbers 6:24 בָּרַךְ בְּקִרְבְּךָ
Hebrew	קָרַב Meaning * Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalms 103:1
ESV	For he strengthens the bars of your gates; he blesses your children within you.
NIV	for he strengthens the bars of your gates and blesses your people within you.
NLT	For he has strengthened the bars of your gates and blessed your children within your walls.
