Meaning

* To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse

Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament.

The word [ברך](#) marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 [ברך בְּנֶיךָ בְּקִרְבְּךָ](#) [קרב](#) [plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big](#)

hebrew

Meaning

* Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial

Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament.

From the root [קרב](#), meaning "to come near, approach." So [קרב](#) is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7 Psalm 103:1

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
