	* Face * Presence * Front or surface
	Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. קָרָהּוּ מִי יַעֲמֹד
ESV	He hurls down his crystals of ice like crumbs; who can stand before his cold?
NIV	He hurls down his hail like pebbles. Who can withstand his icy blast?
NLT	He hurls the hail like stones. Who can stand against his freezing cold?
