Hebrew	יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 בְּעֵמֹךָ יְהוָה לְעֲנֹכִים בִּישׁוּעָה
	ESV For the LORD takes pleasure in his people; he adorns the humble with salvation.
	NIV For the LORD takes delight in his people; he crowns the humble with salvation.
	NLT For the LORD delights in his people; he crowns the humble with victory.
	ἵνα εὐδοκεῖ κύριος ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. λαὸν αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
LXX	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὑψώσει πρᾶξις ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. σωτηρίᾳ
