ESV	Let the godly exult in glory; let them sing for joy on their beds.
NIV	Let the saints rejoice in this honor and sing for joy on their beds.
NLT	Let the faithful rejoice that he honors them. Let them sing for joy as they lie on their beds.
LXX	καυχήσονται ὅσοι ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. δόξη καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀγαλλιάσονται ἐπὶ τῶν greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
