Hebrew	יהוה על כן אודך בגוים יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	Great salvation he brings to his king, and shows steadfast love to his anointed, to David and his offspring forever.
