Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 διηγοῦνται δόξαν θεοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God ποίησιν δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ

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δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. χειρῶν αὐτοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
