	Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalms 115:3 לַמֶּלֶךְ אֱלֹהֵי יִלְעָג לָמוֹ
ESV	He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord holds them in derision.
NIV	The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them.
