IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐπάκουσον ἡμῶν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἥ greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἂν ἡμέρᾳ ἐπικαλεσώμεθα σε
