Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects.

NIV	Be exalted, O LORD, in your strength; we will sing and praise your might.
NLT	Rise up, O LORD, in all your power. With music and singing we celebrate your mighty acts. For the choir director: A psalm of David, to be sung to the tune “Doe of the Dawn.”
