

Psalm 22:10

Hebrew	כִּי אֶתָּה גִּתִּי מִבֶּטֶן מִבְּטְחִי עַל שְׁדֵי אִמִּי
ESV	On you was I cast from my birth, and from my mother's womb you have been my God.
NIV	From birth I was cast upon you; from my mother's womb you have been my God.
NLT	I was thrust into your arms at my birth. You have been my God from the moment I was born.
LXX	ἐπὶ σὲ ἐπερρίφην ἐκ μήτρας ἐκ κοιλίας μητρός μου θεός greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God μου εἶμι greek εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμι is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. οὖ
KJV	I was cast upon thee from the womb: thou art my God from my mother's belly.

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
