	ὁ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἁγίοις κατοικεῖς ὁ LXX greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
