	The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. Genesis 1:1 יִשְׂרָאֵל מְלַל צְרוּתָיו
ESV	Redeem Israel, O God, out of all his troubles.
NIV	Redeem Israel, O God, from all their troubles!
NLT	O God, ransom Israel from all its troubles. A psalm of David.
