NIV	proclaiming aloud your praise and telling of all your wonderful deeds.
NLT	singing a song of thanksgiving and telling of all your wonders.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
