	Meaning
	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
	First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 לְמֹד וּבְמִעוֹד מְשִׁיחַ מְשִׁיחוֹ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigמְשִׁיחַ
ESV	Messiah means “anointed one”
	The Greek word is Christ (Χριστός)
	Masculine, noun הוא
NIV	The LORD is the strength of his people; he is the saving refuge of his anointed.
NLT	The LORD is the strength of his people, a fortress of salvation for his anointed one.
NLT	The LORD gives his people strength. He is a safe fortress for his anointed king.

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὑπερασπιστῆς τῶν greek The definite article σωτηρίων τοῦ greek The definite article χριστοῦ Christ means “anointed one” The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ) Noun, masculine. αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐστίν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
