Hebrew	יהוה קול יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth and strips the forests bare, and in his temple all cry, “Glory!”

NLT	The voice of the LORD twists mighty oaks and strips the forests bare. In his Temple everyone shouts, “Glory!”

	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τις λέγει δόξαν
