This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לִבְּהֶיָּהּ
ESV	For I hear the whispering of many- terror on every side!- as they scheme together against me, as they plot to take my life.
NIV	For I hear the slander of many; there is terror on every side; they conspire against me and plot to take my life.
NLT	I have heard the many rumors about me, and I am surrounded by terror. My enemies conspire against me, plotting to take my life.
