Hebrew	פָּנִים פָּנִים תִּסְתַּר בְּסִתְּרֶךָ פָּנֶיךָ hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. מְרַכְּסֵי אִישׁ תִּצְפֹּנֶם בְּסִכָּה מְרִיב לְשָׁנוֹת
	ESV Blessed be the LORD, for he has wondrously shown his steadfast love to me when I was in a besieged city.
	NIV Praise be to the LORD, for he showed his wonderful love to me when I was in a besieged city.
	NLT Praise the LORD, for he has shown me the wonders of his unfailing love. He kept me safe when my city was under attack.
LXX	ὁ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ἑλεος αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πόλει περιοχῆς
