Hebrew	כִּי יוֹמָם וּלְיָלָה תִּכְבֵּד עָלַי יָדְךָ נִהְפָּךְ לְשִׁדְי בְּחֶרְבִּנִי קִיץ סֶלָה
ESV	For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. Selah
NIV	For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer. Selah
NLT	Day and night your hand of discipline was heavy on me. My strength evaporated like water in the summer heat. Interlude
LXX	ὅτι ἡμέρας καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” νυκτὸς ἐβαρύνθη ἐπ’ ἐμὲ ἢ greek The definite article χείρ σου ἐστράφη ἐν ταλαιπωρίᾳ ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τῷ greek The definite article ἐμπαγῆναι ἄκανθαν διάψαλμα
