	Meaning:
	* The heart * Used figuratively for the feelings, the will and even the intellect * The centre of anything
	Noun, masculine (although conceptually neutral, being used for both men and women). Occurs nearly 600 times in the Old Testament.1 Samuel 25:37Genesis 6:5Exodus 8:151 Samuel 24:51 Samuel 16:7Jeremiah 17:9Deuteronomy 10:16Deuteronomy 6:5Deuteronomy 6:5Psalm 9:1 (NIV)(verse 2 in the Hebrew Bible)Deuteronomy 6:5Genesis 6:51 Samuel 1:13Psalm 95:10Deuteronomy 6:5... הַמִּבִּין אֶל כָּל מַעֲשֵׂיהֶם
ESV	he who fashions the hearts of them all and observes all their deeds.
NIV	he who forms the hearts of all, who considers everything they do.
NLT	He made their hearts, so he understands everything they do.

	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τᾶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ
