Hebrew	הָיָה מְלֶאךָדְּהָיָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הָיָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. 	ESV Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good! Blessed is the man who takes refuge in him!
	NIV Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who takes refuge in him.

	γεύσασθε καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἴδετε ὅτι χρηστὸς ὁ greek The definite article κύριος μακάριος ἀνὴρ ὃς ἐλπίζει ἐπ αὐτόν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
