Hebrew	צֹפֶה רָשָׁע לַצַּדִּיק וּמִבְקֵשׁ לְהַמִּיתוֹ
ESV	The wicked watches for the righteous and seeks to put him to death.
NIV	The wicked lie in wait for the righteous, seeking their very lives;
NLT	The wicked wait in ambush for the godly, looking for an excuse to kill them.
LXX	κατανοεῖ ὁ greek The definite article ἁμαρτωλὸς τὸν greek The definite article δίκαιον καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ζητεῖ τοῦ greek The definite article θανατῶσαι αὐτόν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
