ESV	When you discipline a man with rebukes for sin, you consume like a moth what is dear to him; surely all mankind is a mere breath! Selah
NIV	You rebuke and discipline men for their sin; you consume their wealth like a moth- each man is but a breath. Selah
NLT	When you discipline us for our sins, you consume like a moth what is precious to us. Each of us is but a breath. Interlude

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἄνθρωπος διάψαλμα
