ESV	TO THE CHOIRMASTER. A PSALM OF DAVID. Blessed is the one who considers the poor! In the day of trouble the LORD delivers him;
NIV	Blessed is he who has regard for the weak; the LORD delivers him in times of trouble.
NLT	Oh, the joys of those who are kind to the poor! The LORD rescues them when they are in trouble.
LXX	εἰς τὸ greek The definite article τέλος ψαλμὸς τῷ greek The definite article Δαυὶδ μακάριος ὁ greek The definite article συνίων ἐπὶ πτωχὸν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πένητα ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἡμέρᾳ πονηρᾷ ῥύσεται αὐτὸν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὁ greek The definite article κύριος
