Hebrew	הִיָּה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigהִיָּה hebrew The word הִיָּה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 אֶלֶּה הַיּוֹם אֲנִי אֶלְהֵיךָ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאֶלֶּהִים hebrew Meanings: * God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels Noun, masculine
ESV	These things I remember, as I pour out my soul: how I would go with the throng and lead them in procession to the house of God with glad shouts and songs of praise, a multitude keeping festival.
NIV	These things I remember as I pour out my soul: how I used to go with the multitude, leading the procession to the house of God, with shouts of joy and thanksgiving among the festive throng.
NLT	My heart is breaking as I remember how it used to be: I walked among the crowds of worshipers, leading a great procession to the house of God, singing for joy and giving thanks amid the sound of a great celebration!
