LXX	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” εἰ διεπετάσαμεν χειρας ἡμῶν πρὸς greek Meaning * To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
