Hebrew	אָרץ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאָרץ hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. כִּי רִצִיתָם
ESV	You are my King, O God; ordain salvation for Jacob!
NIV	You are my King and my God, who decrees victories for Jacob.
NLT	You are my King and my God. You command victories for Israel.

LXX	οὐ εἶμι greek εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμι is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. αὐτὸς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὅ greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
