	Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. יְחִלּוּ עֲשִׂירֵי עָם
ESV	All glorious is the princess in her chamber, with robes interwoven with gold.
NIV	All glorious is the princess within her chamber; her gown is interwoven with gold.
NLT	The bride, a princess, looks glorious in her golden gown.
